

Literacy

In phonics, we will continue to learn 'special friends' from set 2 sounds this term and words with 4 and 5 sounds in. We will be building up our word reading skills to read simple sentences.

Our Literacy work will start on the book 'Oi Frog' where we will explore rhyme. After half term we begin with Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch. Our writing will be linked to our quality texts

Maths

We will continue creating a strong sense of number by recognising patterns within numbers and in the number system. We will be looking at numbers up to 20 and beyond.

We will be looking at adding more and taking away. We will be building our number facts such as doubling, sharing and grouping and odd & even numbers.

Religion

We will start with our 'Good news' topic where we share our good news and realise how the disciples felt when they heard the good news about Jesus. Then we will look at friendships and The World. Our world faiths unit this term will be on Islam.

PSHE

We will continue to solving conflicts appropriately and consider the feelings of others.

Computing and E-safety

We will continue to document our learning and the work that we are proud of by using our electronic journal; Seesaw. We will take photographs learning the importance of being sensible as these pictures are going online to our teachers and parents.

We will use simple software to draw, type and play games online.

Physical Development

We will continue to build our finger strength through weekly activities to support our fine motor skills. We will make sure that we are holding our pencils correctly using the 'tripod' grip to support our handwriting.

Our gross motor skills will continue to be developed through outdoor play, including lifting, games and activities. We will work on skills discretely during our PE lessons.
