

English

This term we put all our phonics knowledge into writing. We start with the book Supertato, looking at people who help us and our aspirations for when we are older. After half term we will look at the traditional tale, Jack and the Beanstalk. Our writing will be linked to this and we will include looking at lots of non-fiction texts linked to growth.

Maths

We will be building a strong number sense to 5, looking at comparing numbers, composition and number bonds. We will build up and expand our number knowledge to 10 throughout the term. This includes combining groups and build on our number bonds to 10.

We will also be comparing mass, length and capacity. We will look at 3D shapes and strengthen our knowledge on patterns.

Religion

We learn about different celebrations, those that we might experience and those within the church. Through the Eucharist unit we will begin to learn about Mass. After half term, we will look at the Easter story.

Alongside this, we will learn about other religions and celebrations such as Chinese new year and Judaism.

Computing and E-safety

Children will continue to document their own learning through our electronic journal see-saw.

E-safety will also be talked about in class.

PE

We will continue to build our finger strength through daily dough discos sessions and weekly funky finger activities.

Gross motor skills will be developed through activities within our outdoor provision and through our PE sessions where we will look at stability, movement and games.

Children need to engage in reading each day. This can be their school reading book but also include reading a bedtime story or using their phonics flash cards.

Understanding of the world- Science

We will be learning all about the different roles in the community, comparing our surroundings and learning to take care of the environment. We also look at growth and change through plants and living eggs.

We will be looking at different ways of painting in art for example, finger painting, outdoor painting and painting to music. We will be making our own bookmarks in textiles as we begin to thread. We will also use some of our creative skills to create art linked to Superhero's and the seasons.
