

Literacy

We will be exploring lots of different stories starting with 'Owl Babies'. We will develop our mark making through labels, sentences, speech bubbles, wanted posters, instructions and description. As we start to learn how to read and write the first set of sounds we will use them to blend together to read words and transfer it into our writing; starting with the initial sounds. During the second half term we will look at stories linked to space.

Maths

During the first term we will be looking at matching, sorting and comparing objects and amounts. We will learn to recognise and recite numbers beyond 10,20 where appropriate. We will learn to represent, compare and understand the composition of numbers to 5. We will look at shapes, including their properties, and relate this back to numbers.

Religion

We learn the importance of our names, that they are special and God loves us. We will talk about family and our groups. We will learn about Diwali, the festival of lights and then learn about Jesus' birth through the Nativity story.

PSHE

We are learning to build new relationships with our friends and teachers. We learn how to understand that not everyone may like the same thing and build up to solving conflict in our play.

Computing and E-safety

We will be learning to document our learning and the work that we are proud of by using our electronic journal; Seesaw. We will take photographs learning the importance of being sensible as these pictures are going online to our teachers and parents.

We will use simple software to draw, type and play games online.

Physical Development

We will build our finger strength through daily dough disco sessions. This works on both large shoulder and arm movements down to strengthening the fingers and improving our fine motor skills. We learn to negotiate space through movements. We can use our large construction resources to build strength. After half term we will learn different ways to travel and look at balance and games.
