

English

For the first 4 weeks, we will be recapping the Year 1 objectives to consolidate the children's prior learning. We will be reading a variety of texts which will have different writing outcomes.

We will be focusing on ensuring the children's handwriting is neat and all their letters are neatly and consistently formed.

Maths

In Maths we will start by working on place value. We will be looking at the tens and ones of an given number less than 100. Using this knowledge, the children will be expected to identify, represent and estimate where numbers would be on a number line as well as comparing number sentences.

We will then progress onto addition and subtraction where we will look more closely at number bonds to 20 and 100. We will also be looking at identifying patterns when adding and subtracting.

Religion

Our topic this term will begin by focusing on beginnings. We will study the beginnings we have faced then explore the beginning of the world in relation to God's creation. Following this, we will explore what happens when someone is baptised and the signs and symbols associated with this.

PSHE

We will recognise the importance of The cycle of life and consider how God created us to follow the human life cycle. We will focus on the foundations by introducing the beginning and ending points of the human life.

Computing and E-safety

We are detectives!
We will be looking at solving a mystery by reading and composing emails. We will also be discussing how we can identify emails that are safe to open.

PE

In PE this term the children will be practising different fundamental skills such as skipping, dribbling, catching and jumping.

Science

Children will be working on the topic of 'animals including humans' which will include what an offspring is, basic hygiene, basic needs of survival and exploring what a balanced diet is.

Homework

The children will be given homework every week which will consist of:

- ◆ 10 spellings on a Monday in preparation for a spelling test the following Monday.
- ◆ Maths each week is to spend time on Numbots/ TTRS.
- ◆ Reading (to be completed at least 3 times a week)

Wider Curriculum

In wider curriculum, we are learning all about 'castles' We will be exploring why castles were built and why certain land features were chosen. We will be looking in detail at the structure of Medieval castles and Medieval life. In art we will be exploring mixed media to create collages. In music, the children will be exploring sounds. The theme will be 'ourselves' and children will explore sound effects, the sounds relating to different moods and how to notate pitch shape and duration using simple line graphics
