

English

Our writing will be based around our topic of 'Africa' The children will be writing a narrative that is coherent and includes adjectives, conjunctions and different types of sentences.

In reading we are going to continue focusing on developing our fluency and beginning to answer inference questions about the text to show we understand 'why' something has happened.

Maths

This term we are going to explore multiplication and division. Following this we will focus on identifying fractions of a shape and a number. To end the term, we will begin learning about time where we will focus on o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to.

Religion
