equator	Invisible line around the world that separates the Northern and Southern hemisphere.
ocean	A large area of the sea
savannah	Tropical grasslands with shrubs and trees but not much rainfall
country	Land that is controlled by one government
continent	Large solid area of land
compass	Helps with directions using North, East, South and West.
climate	Average weather conditions over 30 years
season	Four divisions of weather- Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter.
equator	Imaginary line around the middle of the planet.
