

English

At the beginning of Autumn term2, we will be reading 'Coming to England' by Floella Benjamin. We will discuss the true story about how Floella and her family came to England and write a letter home from Dardie. We will then read the 'Queens hat' and write a diary of where the hat visited each day around London. We will meet Katie and go on an adventure around Scotland maybe we will meet Nessey! We will look at Wales and design a holiday poster and visit Ireland to gather information to write a leaflet. Moving into Advent, we will write a recount of the Christmas story and a letter to Santa after reading 'Santa's Post' Focusing on capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Maths

In maths we will start by looking at geometry, recognising and naming 2D shapes, moving onto recognising and sorting 3D shapes. We will complete this element by looking at patterns with 2D and 3D shapes. We will then focus on place value within 20. Counting forwards and backward and writing numerals to 50 and numeral words to 20. We will look at tens and ones and develop number recognition for one more and one less. We will look at grouping numbers and ordering from smallest to biggest and the symbols than represent this. We will be counting in 2s, 10s and 5s. Learning our number bonds to 10 and 15 and how to double and half numbers.

Religion

Our topic this term will begin with focusing on Baptism We will explore how our lives are marked by many different experiences of being welcomed into new situations and groups. We will look at how God welcomes us into his family in this special way. We will then move into Advent and prepare for the joyful coming of Jesus by retelling and acting out the Nativity story.

PSHE

Children will have a basic understanding that feelings and actions are two different things, and that our good actions can 'form' our feelings and our character and that choices may have consequences.

Computing and E-safety

Children will be taught about e-safety and keeping safe when using the internet.

We will be using the computers to create a digital greeting card. We will be organising and manipulating both text and images then storing and retrieving our work to improve it.

PE

During this term we will be will be working with a coach from Manchester United focusing on out control skills.

Science

Children will be working on the topic of 'Seasonal Changes'. We will look at the four season within our year and observe changes across the four seasons. We will be recording and observing the weather on a daily basis and considering how the day length changes. We will look at the changes in our environment and discuss how we deal with these changes.

Wider Curriculum

In geography children will name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries & capital cities of the UK.

D&T we will design a moving vehicle using the skill to assemble, join & combine materials and explore how we can make it stronger, stiffer and more stable. In art we will create a collage using a variety of textiles.
