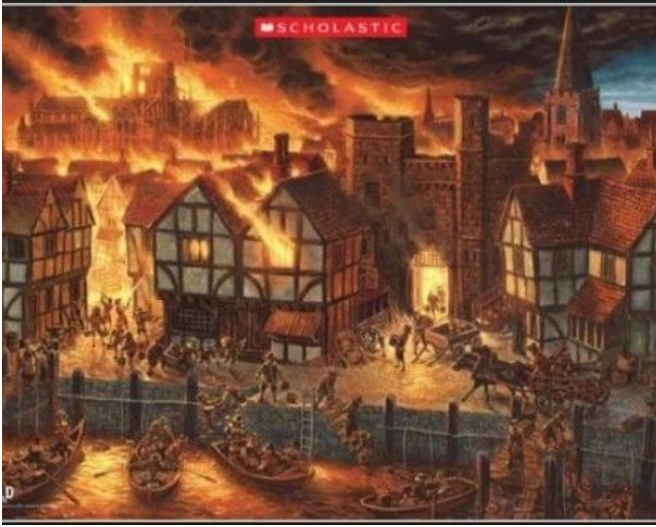


Great Fire of London: KS1 Knowledge Mat

Fire hooks	A giant hook used to pull down houses	☐ The fire started on Sunday 2 nd September 1666 in a bakery on Pudding Lane. It lasted for 5 days	
Plague	A contagious disease that makes people very poorly	☐ The houses in London were mainly made from wood and straw which is flammable, especially when it is dry.	
Firebreak	A gap that stops a fire spreading to nearby buildings	☐ The houses were very close together so the wind could easily spread	
Puddling lane	The street where the fire started	☐ 13,200 houses were destroyed in the fire and 70,000 people were made homeless	
Bakery	A place that makes bread, cakes etc.	☐ After the fire, King Charles II said houses needed to be built apart and to be made from stone, not wood.
