

English

This term we will be reading a variety of books linked to China with writing outcomes linked to the purpose. We will be particularly focusing on adding suffixes to adjectives to change their meaning and using the correct tense consistently throughout their writing.

In reading, we will be working on taking turns and listening to what others say. In addition, we will be focusing on developing our retrieval and vocabulary comprehension skills.

Maths

This term we are going to focus on recognising and using symbols for money as well as combining money to make different amounts. We will then progress to explore how to multiply and divide using concrete and pictorial representations.

Religion

In RE we will be looking at how our experience of community is essential and enjoyable for people of every age and faith.

PSHE

In RSE this term we will be exploring our relationships with others and build upon the understanding that we have been created out of love and for love. We will look at strategies for developing healthy relationships and keeping safe.

We will continue looking at being safe online.

PE

This term the children will be focusing on developing their spinning, turning and twisting technique through gymnastics.

The children will also explore how to develop their jumping technique and throwing whilst running through athletics.
