

English

In Autumn 2, we will be reading a variety of books which link with the Great Fire of London with different writing outcomes linked to different purposes. During this term, we are going to build up our stamina for writing and work on writing coherent sentences. We will be working on including coordinating and subordinating conjunctions as well as expanded noun phrases.

Maths

In Maths, we are going to continue working on addition and subtraction using concrete objects then progressing to using the column method. We will then focus on applying these skills to problem solve. Following this, the children will then focus on properties of 2d and 3d shapes.

Religion

In RE we are going to look at 'preparation' linking to the season of Advent to develop the understanding that gifts received or given are a symbol of love.

PSHE

In RSE we will be looking at what makes us unique, what makes girls and boys different, what it means to be clean and healthy and the cycle of life.

Computing and E-safety

In computing we will be researching about the Great Fire of London.

For e safety we will be looking at what private information is.

PE

This term in Year 2 the children will be working closely with the Manchester United coach. The skill they will be focusing on is hopping along a straight line using one foot. The children will incorporate this skill with gymnastics and striking and fielding games.

We will also be identifying the importance of our senses and explain how they help us.
