

English

At the beginning of Spring term 2 we will be reading 'The Spider Sandwich' and creating our own delicious insect sandwich! We will then read, 'The Disgusting Sandwich' and look at adjectives that describe the nouns in the story. We will then innovate the story to create our own version, changing the events and linking the characters to our D&T.

We will then read 'Sam's Sandwich' and compare this book with 'Spider Sandwich' and discuss similarities and differences between the books. We will look at how the books rhyme and write adjectives to describe objects we would include in our sandwich. We will learn how to join two clauses together using 'but' and 'and'.

Maths

In maths we will continue with addition and subtraction within 20, focusing on finding the difference, related facts and concluding this section with missing number problems. We will then progress onto place value within 50, counting from 20 to 50 and developing our understanding of multiples of 10 to 50. We will learn how to count groups of objects more efficiently by grouping into tens and ones. Children develop their understanding of place value for 2-digit numbers as they begin to partition numbers to 50. They have already explored how many tens and ones make a number and they now use a part-whole model to partition a number into tens and ones. We will continue to consolidate number bonds to 20, counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s

Religion

We begin this term in the season of Lent. We will be looking at the importance of Shrove Tuesday and make pancakes. We will then receive our ashes on Ash Wednesday which marks the beginning of 40 days of Lent up to Easter. We will make a Lenten promise and discuss ways that we can be charitable throughout this period. During this time of preparation for Easter we will be looking at changes in our lives and the world consider making a new start. We will be looking at the journey Jesus took and the special times he spent with his disciples, Palm Sunday, the last supper and Jesus dying on the cross.

PSHE—Special People Children will interact with a film to help them to identify appropriate and inappropriate behaviours and the effects that they can have.

Computing and E-safety

Children will be taught about e-safety and keeping safe when using the internet.

We are painters – Using the computers we will be painting and labelling.

PE

During this term we will be working with a coach from Manchester United focusing on our control skills.

We will have a visitor to teach us all about mindfulness and how it can help us in our day to lives.
