

English

In the first part of the term our work will be centred around the novel 'The Children of Benin'. We will develop our use of narrative and incorporate speech to advance the action. We will advance our vocabulary range to include higher level, complex vocabulary within our writing. We will look at our use of formal and informal and develop our editing skills. As we continue into the next term, we will be looking at effective poetry and the features used. We will link this to our celebration of diversity and inclusiveness.

Maths

In Maths we will begin by focussing on number and Place Value. We will recap previous learning in year groups and develop our understanding to apply in a range of problems to continue to build our reasoning skills. We will then move onto addition and subtraction and using this knowledge to apply in various mathematical concepts.

Religion

In RE, we will begin our learning by completing our topic based on Love. There will be links to the story of the Prodigal Son and the Beatitudes. We will then look at the vocations and commitments of other people.

PSHE We will be holding classroom discussions based on the children's worries and to continue to help prepare them for future transitions.

Computing and E-safety

We will begin the term by designing our own magazine based on our learning and research of the Kingdom of Benin. We will then become advertisers by using different software and programs to create our own advertisements to sell our products linked to our D&T. E-safety will be continuously taught and linked in all aspects of the curriculum.

PE

In PE, we will be further developing our throwing and catching skills and applying it to different games settings; this will be completed with the MUF coach.

The children will then move on to learning how to play lacrosse; the handling of the equipment and body movements.
