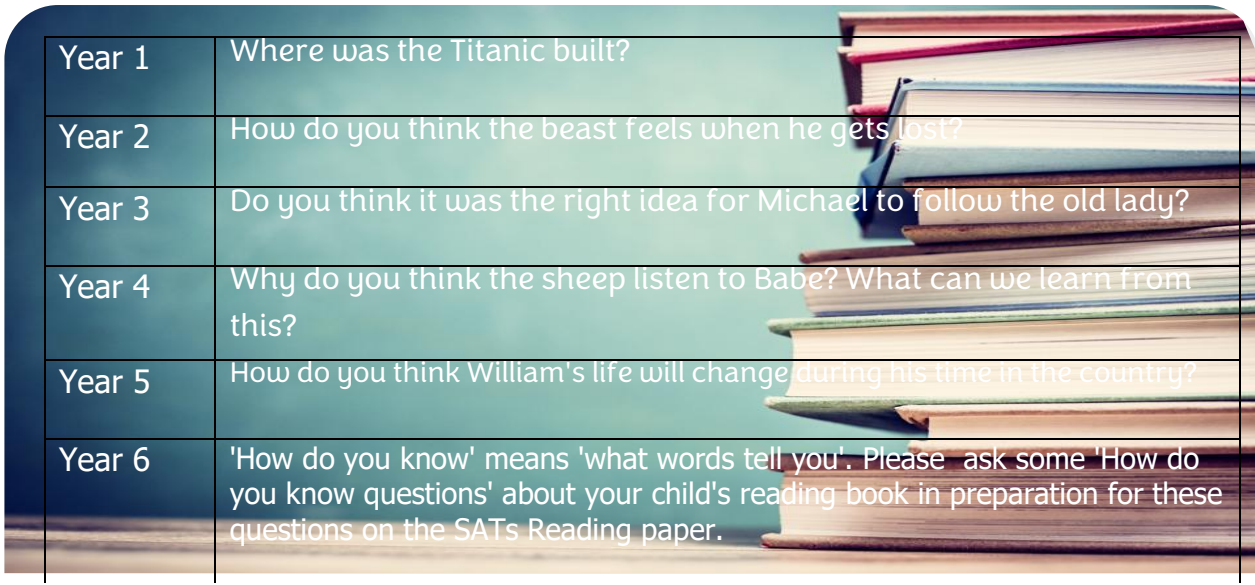

Year 4	Why do you think the sheep listen to Babe? What can we learn from this?
Year 5	How do you think William's life will change during his time in the country?
Year 6	'How do you know' means 'what words tell you'. Please ask some 'How do you know questions' about your child's reading book in preparation for these questions on the SATs Reading paper.
